

## Obtaining an Antillian driver's license

When changing a foreign driver's license into an Antillian driver's license you need to do the following:

1. Write a request to the Local Chief of Police (which is the Lieutenant Governor) on a fls. 5,00 stamp paper (this you get at the Receiver's Office at the Government Administration Building) requesting permission to change over your current driver's license to an Antillian one. A copy of your current driver's license should be attached to this request, and your local telephone number if you have one in the event that we need to contact you.

After this request has been submitted and approved by the Local Chief of Police, you can then proceed with the following.

2. A Medical Form (fls. 6,00) must be purchased at the Receiver's Office. This must be signed by Dr. Anita Radix.
3. You should also bring along two passport pictures, a copy of your passport, a copy of your temporary residency permit, a proof of registration (which you request at the Census Office) and purchase fls. 21,00 stamps at the Receiver's Office. These are the official stamps that appear on your driver's license.

The above mentioned documents should be turned in to Miss Amorelle Granger at the Government Administration Building.
